After all but one other Republican challenger in the 2024 presidential primary elections dropped out of the race, former **President Donald Trump** easily exceeded winning the 1,215 convention delegates needed to assure his nomination on Super Tuesday.



On that date, March 5, Trump gained a large majority of the votes cast in 14 state primaries or caucuses: Alabama, Alaska, Arkansas, California, Colorado, Maine, Massachusetts, Minnesota, North Carolina, Oklahoma, Tennessee, Texas, Utah, and Virginia.

Vermont, the 15^{th} state on Super Tuesday, went instead to former **South Carolina Governor Nikki Haley**, who also dropped out the presidential race the next day.

In his victory speech, Trump focused on familiar themes, including the invasion of the U.S. by illegal aliens, apparently with the full support of Joe Biden's administration. "They want to open borders, and open borders will destroy our country," he said. "We need borders and free and fair elections otherwise we don't have a country." He added, "Success will bring unity to our country."

Earlier in March, Trump won campaigns in Arkansas and California, and then on March 12 in Georgia, Hawaii, Mississippi, and Washington. On March 19, he captured the convention delegates in Arizona, Florida, Illinois, Kansas and Ohio, and on March 23 in Louisiana.

POLITICAL JOTTINGS AND DOTTINGS



--Following Ronna McDaniel's announced resignation as chair of the Republican National Committee, meeting in Houston on March 8, the RNC named general counsel Michael Whatley as the new chair, and Donald Trump's daughter-in-law, Lara Trump, as the new co-chair. Both were hand-

picked by the former President.

Whatley vowed to work "hand in glove" with Trump in his campaign to defeat Joe Biden in the November election. Lara Trump stressed the significance of fundraising and early voting. McDaniel advised her replacements to not let Republican candidates bury their heads in the sand on the abortion issue, attract swing and independent voters, compete with Democrats in early and absentee voting, and not engage in GOP infighting that the media so desperately craves. She had vocally supported Trump in the past, but the failure to produce a "red wave" in the 2022 midterm sparked friction within the Republican Party.

--Special elections are planned for later this year for four congressional seats vacated by resignations, and it could have

an impact on which party controls the House, since three of them were held by Republicans: **Bill Johnson** in Ohio's 6th District; **Kevin McCarthy** in California's 20th District; and **Ken Buck**, in Colorado's 4th District. The Democrat who left office to take another position was Brian Higgins, in New York's 26th District.

The California open Congressional primary was held on March 19, and two Republicans earned the right to battle on May 21 for that vacant seat. The candidates are **State Assemblyman Vince Fong and Mike Boudreaux** of the Tulare County Sheriff's Department.

In Ohio on March 19, businessman **Bernie Moreno** won the Republican Senate Primary and will face the Democrat incumbent, Sherrod Brown, on November 5 election day.

In 2006, Hamas ran openly for the first time in legislative elections in Gaza, and won by the largest number of seats, ousting the Palestinian Authority and wrested control of the region to them. One year later they

established physical control of Gaza, cementing its political and military control over the area. That was the last election "democratically" held in Gaza, as Hamas had established an iron grip there.

According to Reuters, "Hamas' 1988 founding charter calls for Israel's destruction and it refuses to recognize Israel. Hamas leaders have at times offered a long-term truce in return for a viable Palestinian state on all territory occupied by Israel in 1967."

In December 2012, Khaled Mashaal, a leader in exile, reflected the traditional Hamas hardline. "The state will come from resistance, not negotiation. Liberation first, then statehood. Palestine is ours from the river to the sea and from the south to the north," he said in speeches. He continued. "We will never recognize the legitimacy of the Israeli occupation, and therefore there is no legitimacy for Israel."

"From the River To The Sea" has become a rallying cry on college campuses and demonstrations around our country. But what does it mean?

Our President has insisted that a two-state solution would be equitable to both the Palestinians and Israel. Simply put the creation of a Palestinian state next to Israel would end the crisis. There would be two states on the land between the Jordan River and the Mediterranean Sea.

The idea of a terrorist state abutting Israel is inviting October 7th attacks every day. Hamas is one part of the Muslim Brotherhood. Hamas is not the only terrorist organization the Muslim Brotherhood supports. "Al Qaeda serves as the core of a loose umbrella organization that includes members of many Sunni Islamic extremist groups, including factions of the

Egyptian Islamic Jihad (EIJ), the Gama'at al-Islamiyya (IG), and the Harakat ul-Mujahidin (HUM)" (PBS Frontline).

With these threats to the nation of Israel, a two state solution is ludicrous. This administration ignores these basic facts as they try to coerce Israel to accept their plan. This plan goes back to Barrack Obama's plans for Israel to remove the settlements in Gaza and sent Vice President Biden to relay this message to the Israeli government. The idea was that these territories be held in reserve for a future two state solution.



To add insult to injury, Biden said on an open microphone that he was going to have a "come to Jesus" conversation with Benjamin Netanyahu. He has pushed the Israeli Prime Minister to change his tactics in Gaza and warned

him not to enter Rafa without U.S. approval of Netanyahu's plans first.

Enter Chuck Schumer. His remarks on March 14 came at a volatile moment in the war. As reported by "The Wall Street Journal," his call for new elections "roils the Democrat Party and divides American Jews. It was applauded by President

Biden, and many senior Democrats have echoed Schumer's calling for new elections in Israel, describing Prime Minister Benjamin Netanyahu's government as an "obstacle to peace amid his country's ongoing war in Gaza." Schumer, the highest-



ranking Jewish official in U.S. history, urged Israel to "do better," citing the estimated tens of thousands of Palestinian civilian casualties caused by the Netanyahu government's military offensive aimed at neutralizing the terrorist group Hamas. What was left out was the massacre of Israelis on that fateful day in October. According to Wikipedia, "The Law of Return is an Israeli law, passed on 5 July 1950, which gives Jews, people with one or more Jewish grandparent, and their spouses the right to relocate to Israel and acquire Israeli citizenship." Is this the Israel Schumer would like to return to?



In the meantime, Biden had said in July 2020 "Foreign

interference in the U.S. electoral process represents an assault on the American people and their constitutional right to vote. When foreign states direct hackers, trolls, money launderers, and misinformation to subvert or cast doubt on our elections, they threaten America's sovereignty, democratic institutions, and national security. They undermine the vote and the voice of every U.S. citizen. They attack our very way of life."

Ironic, isn't it? While ranting about foreign interference in our elections trying to change the course of our nation, he finds no problem with interfering in Israel's government. It would be convenient to say that these are new demands but, as stated earlier, this goes back to President Obama and then V.P. Biden.

What does this say to our allies? Are we a nation that supports our allies or do we bow to the pressure of the Left in our nation and be governed by their philosophy, even if it means abandoning our relations with other nations? MAYFIELD MINUTE By Florida District 17 State Senator Debbie Mayfield

Florida's 126th Regular Session of the State Legislature since Statehood in 1845 was declared Sine Die at 2:25 p.m. on Friday, March 8. My Senate colleagues and I worked around the

clock to amend and pass a number of bills and to provide a thoughtful and comprehensive budget of \$117.46 billion. During my farewell speech on the Senate floor, I shared how deeply grateful and honored I am to have represented the citizens of Brevard County and Indian River County.

Highlights achieved during the session included:

- Fiscal responsibility.
- Florida as the law-and-order state and recognizing that law enforcement officers and first responders are valued and honored in our state.
- Greater protections for Floridians from illegal immigration.
- New and continuing tax reliefs for Florida families.
- Measures taken to fight back against the Chinese Communist Party and their interests in Florida.
- Putting a stop to the 'WOKE' agenda.
- Prioritizing parental rights and protecting children.

The Florida Senate and House both passed the 2024-2025 state budget of \$117.46 billion for consideration by Governor Ron DeSantis, giving him 15 days from the date he received it to sign the bill and/or exercise line-item vetoes.

Senate budget highlights included:

- Significant investments in education for public school funding with \$1.2 billion for teacher salaries and \$1.7 billion for early learning services, and additional funding for school choice opportunities.
- The payoff of \$500 million in state debt and the setting aside of \$10 billion in state reserves, and critical funding to prepare and recover from natural disasters.
- Nearly \$10 billion in agriculture and environment funding.
- Approximately \$1.5 billion in tax relief for families and small businesses, a reduction of taxes on property insurance premiums, and continuation of statewide sales tax holidays.
- Over \$46 billion for the "Live Health" initiative to increase access to health care services and for critical funding for qualified health care centers, rural clinics, adoption services, and state nursing homes.
- Approximately \$220 million for Veteran health care services and \$38 million in funding for the Agency for Persons with Disabilities to expand and support residents

- in need of home and community-based health care services.
- Nearly \$11 million to increase services for 2,250 seniors needing home and community based care.
- Approximately \$174 million for the "Live Local Act" which provides affordable housing options and other rental assistance.
- Over \$17 million to fund law enforcement bonuses to recruit officers to serve and protect our communities.

Florida Attorney General Ashley Moody testified at the Supreme Court of the United States defending the State's right to protect citizens from Big Tech censorship. The oral argument followed a multi-year legal challenge to Senate Bill 7072, which:

- Prohibits social media companies from censoring and shadow-banning.
- Prohibits prioritization of posts in a way that is inconsistent and unfair.
- Prohibits the de-platforming of U.S. political candidates or journalistic enterprises.
- Requires social media platforms to meet certain requirements when restricting the speech of users.

"Social media is the new town square, but the Big Tech CEOs who control these platforms argue they should have unfettered power to silence voices they don't agree with, de-platform people who challenge corporate media narratives, and shadow ban candidates who don't share their Silicon Valley values," Moody said. "We are fighting in the U.S. Supreme Court for Floridians to debate ideas, engage in political discourse, and question government policies on social media platforms." -0-

Governor Ron DeSantis announced a milestone in Florida's continuing economic success citing that the state's unemployment rate has been lower than the national unemployment rate for 40 consecutive months. The national unemployment rate rose to 3.9% for February 2024, Florida's rate of 3.1% did not rise, and continues to outperform the national rate by 0.8%.

While Florida's private sector job growth rate increased by 2.3% (+194,200 jobs) over the year in February 2024, the national rate grew by only 1.6% over the same period.

"Florida continues to outperform the nation," DeSantis said. "We have proven that bold, conservative leadership across the board produces booming economic results--more jobs, lower taxes, less regulation, and fiscal security."

Also, locally, I am bringing home nearly \$10 Million in state funding for critical health care projects that will benefit a diverse array of constituents.

We've also made strides in affordable housing, with initiatives aimed at expanding access to home ownership and maintaining the character of our communities. The allocation of \$100 million for the Florida Hometown Hero Program is a testament to our dedication to making the state an affordable place to live for those who serve our communities.

Tax relief has been a key focus, with over \$1.5 billion in broad-based tax relief measures designed to ease the financial burden on Floridian families and small businesses. From sales tax holidays to reductions in taxes on property insurance premiums, these measures put more money back into the pockets of hardworking Floridians.




THE BREC CORNER By Chairman Rick Lacey

March was a busy month for Brevard Federated Republican

Women! Along with our regular monthly luncheon on March 6, we hosted our biennial Red Wave To Victory Dinner on March 16, and set up a tent at early voting locations March 9-16 for the Florida Presidential Primary Election.

Our March Luncheon guest speaker was **Barbara Rumpel**, one of 16 female National Rifle Association Board Members, and a member of the Executive Committee of the NRA's Women's Leadership Forum. She gave an inspiring talk on our Second Amendment rights and our responsibility to defend those rights,



and she informed us that the NRA is a target of the federal government and progressive gun control organizations. Leticia James, the attorney general of New York, referred to the NRA as a "criminal enterprise" and a "terrorist organization," Rumpel said.

Using backdoor threats and other tactics to get financial institutions to stop doing business with the NRA, she said, James attempted to silence the organization. Despite James' best efforts, she has been unsuccessful in her efforts to disband the NRA.

Rumpel said more than throughout the nation, 190 individuals, including attorneys, and organizations as well, have filed interest papers in support of the NRA's legal opposition. No other organization has done more over the years than NRA to ensure that our constitutional right to bear arms is realized, and we still have our Second Amendment rights because of the NRA, Rumpel added.

She said that NRA is not going to pause; they will continue to fight gun control legislation, and to protect our Second Amendment rights state by state.

Rumple also told us that the NRA has a variety of training programs. It established its law enforcement division in 1960,

specifically to provide the law enforcement community with the means to certify law enforcement firearm instructors. Any public law enforcement officer who is a member of the NRA is automatically insured and receives \$35,000 in life insurance if they are killed in the line of duty.

Rumpel urged all of us to become members of the NRA. We cannot afford to slow down our efforts to save our country because the Second Amendment is so vital to us. Several hundred Brevardians packed the Boniface-Hiers Chevrolet Showroom in Melbourne on March 24 to meet Florida Congressman Bill Posey and Ohio Congressman Jim Jordan. Posey spoke

Weldon said he fought for Brevard County and for conservative

Current issues that are causing struggles in Brevard, he said, include the condition of roads, rising rates for homeowner and car insurance, education, and the cost of healthcare. who served in Iraq with the 82nd Airborne Division, Florida 7th District Congressman Cory Mills has done it yet again – rising to the occasion to save Americans from danger in other countries. In 2021, he coordinated efforts to extract Americans from the chaos in Afghanistan after the disastrous withdrawal led by the Biden administration. In 2023, he facilitated

the safe return of stranded citizens from Israel during a period of heightened tension in the region. UNIVERSITY OF FLORIDA. Florida Governor Ron DeSantis, who had made halting DEI a cornerstone of his efforts to overhaul education in the state, said, "DEI is toxic and has no place in our public universities. I'm glad that Florida was the first state to eliminate DEI, and I hope more states follow suit."

MOMS FOR LIBERTY. Reporting about a CBS "60 Minutes" interview by Scott Pelley of Moms For Liberty co-founders **Tina Descovich** and **Tiffany Justice**, the website Conservative Underground News said that "Democrats and their media allies, are doing everything they can to convince working-class"



Americans that woke indoctrination in government schools is a figment of their imaginations." But Descovich explained to Pelley that young school children are looking at books where sexual discussions are happening, and Justice read excerpts

from one, providing evidence of graphic content infiltrating school libraries and classrooms. The website said Pelley "didn't know what hit him" after the two women "put him in his place on woke indoctrination in government schools." In the war over education, the Conservative Underground News said, "Moms for Liberty stands firm, determined to safeguard the innocence of America's youth and hold government schools accountable for what they deem as inappropriate content. Parents should be encouraged by the Moms for Liberty to speak out and to not let their voices be silenced by Democrats and their media allies."

Scott said, "the fentanyl crisis has plagued our communities and caused crushing heartbreak to those who lose loved ones to these dangerous drugs. As fentanyl continues to flow illegally into the U.S. over the southern border and kills tens of thousands of our citizens, we must do more to support our brave CBP agents, and all who are on the front lines of this battle to ensure they have every tool needed to keep these dangerous drugs out of our communities."



The latest edition of "SPNNews" reports that at the network's 31st annual meeting last year, held in Chicago, the highest number of attendees

on the growth of government. AUDACITY AND IDIOCY

"Winners" this month include:



--Arizona Democrat Governor Katie Hobbs, for vetoing legislation passed by the State Legislature that would

have allowed police to arrest illegal aliens who cross the border into the state.

--Nieves Riedel, the new Mayor of San Luis, Arizona, for shutting down the Gethsemani Baptist Church and its Pastor, Jose Castro, from feeding hungry families not only in San Luis, but surrounding areas in Arizona and even into California as well for the past 25 years. Former San Luis City Council members even helped with the food distribution. But now, a city code enforcer has been issuing citations to the pastor, resulting in municipal court fines to get him to stop the practice. In response, First Liberty Institute has filed suit in federal court to stop the city from abusing its code, saying churches should not be threatened or fined for feeding the hungry, which "betrays everything that religious freedom in America is about."

--The Massachusetts Department of Children and Families, for denying a couple – Mike (an Iraqi war veteran) and Kitty (a paraprofessional for special needs kids) Burke – an opportunity to foster and adopt children in the state "because of their religious beliefs about gender and human sexuality." The couple, who own their own business and are active in their church, are now suing Massachusetts for its discriminatory program. Their attorney noted that "the crisis has become so extreme," the state has resorted to housing children in hospitals for weeks on end.

--The social media company Tik-Tok, for "challenging" young subscribers to "chrome" – in other words, to inhale aerosol paint and other chemical products in an attempt to get high. In Lancaster, England, it cost an 11-year-old boy – Tommie-Lee Gracie Billington – his life. His devastated family said he went into cardiac arrest and was pronounced dead at a local hospital.

--Illinois Federal Judge Sharon Johnson Coleman, who was appointed to the bench by former President Barack Obama, for ruling in favor of granting illegal immigrants the right to carry firearms. Plaintiffs in a case argued that denying them the right violated their Second Amendment rights, and Coleman said, "The Second Amendment applies to all individuals within the United States, regardless of their immigration status." Critics of her decision called it "a dangerous precedent that undermines the rule of law and national security."



YOU CAN'T MAKE THIS UP

--In a major move by the Biden administration, over 150,000 borrowers of federal student loans can expect to receive a personal email congratulating them on their newfound debt forgiveness. The plan, which will cost American

taxpayers \$1.2 billion, is the latest in a series of actions taken by President Biden to address the student loan crisis. According to Politico, the administration has already canceled a whopping \$138 billion in debt for nearly 4 million borrowers since Biden took office in 2021. This latest round of loan forgiveness is part of the president's Save Student Aid Forgiveness for Education (SAVE) Plan, which aims to make higher education more accessible and affordable for all Americans. In the email, borrowers will receive a message from President Biden himself, reminding them that he is their champion in the fight against student loan debt.

--According to conversativenewszone.com, when a 37-year-old mother in Canada named Kayla Pollack received a Moderna COVID booster shot in January 2022, she became paralyzed from the neck down, and her doctors fully admit the injection was responsible. Pollack now describes her life as a "living hell," and blames the Canadian government for coercing everyone to "get the shot," and now the doctors have offered to "make it up to her" – by euthanizing her. Instead, the Veterans for Freedom organization is raising funds to help her family purchase a wheelchair van and a service dog for her.

--After a Pennsylvania State Police trooper pulled over a car on an interstate highway for being driven with an expired and suspended registration, without headlights activated in the rain, having illegally tinted windows and being too close to another car, the driver, Celena Morrison, Philadelphia's executive director of the Office of LGBT Affairs, and her husband, Darius McLean — in a heated confrontation — were charged with resisting arrest, obstruction of justice, disorderly conduct, and summary traffic citations. But after City District Attorney Larry Krasner declined the charges, the couple was released from

custody – and the unnamed state trooper was placed on restricted duty.

--When student Cameron Blasek parked his truck at East Central High School in St. Leon, Indiana, school administrators ordered him to remove a symbol from it. Even though he pointed out that there was no school policy against displaying the symbol, the administrators still wrote him up. But the next day, in support of their classmate, two dozen other students showed up with the same symbol in their vehicles. And the day after that rows and rows of students' trucks showed up at school the same way as well. So that forced the principal to backtrack – and advise students and their parents that the symbol will be allowed after all. So, what was this symbol that had the school administrators so uptight? It was none other than Old Glory – the Stars and Stripes of the American Flag. It seems in Indiana; the students are more patriotic than the administrators.

--More fun and games from the nightmare that is California. Moronic officials in the fair city of Oakland have no clue about who vandalizes private property there, but they have no qualms about threatening victimized homeowners with massive fines if they don't immediately clean up the mess. The latest victim, Victor Silva, whose backyard fence was painted with graffiti, received a citation to remove it or face a \$1,100 fine, subject to an additional \$1,277 fine for each failed inspection. A simple task, no? Perhaps not, for a wheelchair bound 102-year-old man.

--After Staci Barber, a teacher at Texas' Cardiff Junior High, joined other people at the school's flagpole to pray prior to the beginning of the school day, Principal Bryan Rounds said it was "against the law" for them to pray publicly "where students could see them," and pointed to a school policy that prohibited teachers from praying in the presence of students. He added that he "might have to have someone else" to replace Barber because of absences she had due to a health issue. In response, the American Center for Law and Justice is taking Rounds to court over the matter, saying the teacher's rights to religious expression were being violated, and that the Constitution "protects the rights of religious employees to pray, even publicly."

--When a Planet Fitness member in Alaska, Patricia Silva, photographed a man in the women's locker room freaking out a little girl there, posted it online, and complained to the staff, her membership was cancelled. Defending the move, a spokesman said the company's "gender identity non-discrimination policy" is committed to creating an inclusive environment. Ensuing publicity, however, led to Planet Fitness' stock price plummeting by \$400 million. On a more amusing note, the satirical website "The Babylon Bee" announced that Planet Fitness has been rated "Best Gym in America" – by The National Association of Perverts.

Manhattan Institute Fellow and commentator Heather MacDonald, writing on disparate impact thinking in the Hillsdale College publication "Imprimis":

"The most consequential falsehood in American public policy today is the idea that any racial disparity in any institution is by definition the result of racial



discrimination. If a cancer research lab, for example, does not have 13 percent black oncologists – the black share of the national population - it is by definition a racist lab that discriminates against competitively qualified black oncologists; if an airline company doesn't have 13 percent black pilots, it is by definition a racist airline company that discriminates against competitively qualified black pilots; and if a prison population contains more than 13 percent black prisoners, our law enforcement system is racist. The claim that racial disparities are proof of racial discrimination has been percolating in academia and the media for a long time. After the George Floyd race riots of 2020, however, it was adopted by America's most elite institutions, from big law and big business to big finance. Even museums and orchestras took up the cry. Many thought that STEM – the fields of science, technology, engineering, and mathematics – would escape the diversity of sledgehammers. They were wrong. The American Medical Association today insists that medicine is characterized by white supremacy.... As a result of this falsehood, we are eviscerating meritocratic and behavioral standards in accordance with what is known as 'disparate impact analysis.' Consider medicine. Step One of the medical licensing exams, taken during or after the second year of medical school, tests medical students' knowledge of anatomy, physiology, and pathology. On average, black students score lower on the grading curve, making it harder for them to land their preferred residencies. Step One, in other words, has a 'disparate impact' on black medical students. The solution, implemented last year, was to eliminate the Step One grading disparity by instituting a pass-fail system. Hospitals choosing residents can no longer distinguish between high and low achieving students – and that is precisely the point.... The federal government is shifting medical research funding from pure science to studies on racial disparities and social justice. Why? Not because of any assessment of scientific need, but simply because black researchers do more racism research and less pure science. The National Institutes of Health has broadened the criteria for receiving neurology grants to include things like childhood welfare receipt because considering

scientific accomplishment alone results in a disparate impact.... It is urgent that we fight back against disparate impact thinking. As long as racism remains the only allowable explanation for racial disparities, the Left wins, and our civilization will continue to crumble. Even the arts are coming down. Classical music, visual art, theater - all are dismissed as a function of white oppression.... A 'gotaway' is recorded when cameras or sensors detect illegals crossing the border, but no one is found, or border agents were not available to respond. Illegal immigrants total 8.7 million. The number is substantially higher if one includes gotaways who avoided detection and thus are more dangerous. 10 million or more is the probable number of illegal immigrants. Deadly drugs are crossing the border. Over 110,000 Americans died of drug overdose in 2023, with fentanyl

accounting for two-thirds of the deaths. China manufactures fentanyl precursor chemicals and ships them on Chinese ships to Manzanillo, a Chinese-controlled Mexican port. The chemicals are then shipped to a Chinese-controlled fentanyl manufacturing facility in Mexico with 2000 Chinese nationals. The drugs are distributed through an alliance of Chinese and Mexican drug cartels to the United States. Chinese students on education visas launder the drug monies collected from drug sales through Chinese state-owned banks. Violent crimes of rape, robbery, and murder are surging with illegal immigrants....TV, newspapers, social media, and websites all tell of illegal immigrant crimes: Police are attacked in New York City, with the attacker being released the next day, flashing the high sign; a University of Georgia coed was murdered while running; almost two-thirds of federal arrests involve noncitizens. In 2023, U.S. Custom and Border Protection encountered 169 persons on the terror watch list and 15,267 with criminal convictions.
