Speaking to more than 400 enthusiastic Brevardians at their annual Lincoln/Reagan Dinner May 25 in Port\Canaveral, **South Dakota Governor Kristi Noem** said it is time to start talking about the consequences of the 2024 presidential election, because while Republicans have not been winning the hearts and minds of people, "there is no reason why we cannot win."



She said she loves that former President Trump "is who he is," and "he never quits on us, so we should never quit on him." The governor added, "Mr. President, I just need you to win." And there was a large audience reaction of support when she surprisingly added, "Let's be honest – Joe Biden sucks."

Critical of the leftist media, Noem said the administration is allowing it to present a false

said the administration is allowing it to present a false impression of the election. She called out much of the media as "liars."

Governor Kathy Hochul could only disparage their choice and right. She appeared on television and said this diverse crowd of working-class Americans -- her constituents – were nothing but "clowns."

--In yet another example of a Joe Biden gaffe, he confusedly said at a recent NAACP event in Michigan that during the coronavirus pandemic, when he was vice president, and things were kind of bad in Detroit, Barack Obama told him to "Go to Detroit, Help fix it." Biden said the "poor mayor spent more time with me than he ever thought he would have to." The problem: the pandemic did not start until three years after the Obama-Biden team left office. Denouncing the January 6 riot at the U.S. Capitol, Biden called those who participated "irrectionists." When the White House issued the official version of his text, several changes were made, including calling the "pandemic" a "recession," and the "irrectionists" as "insurrectionists." According to "The Daily Caller," just in 2024 alone, the president's spoken words have undergone more than 150 corrections.

Noem said that in response to the administration opening the southern border to illegal aliens, her state of South Dakota was the first one to send the state's national guard down to help control matters. South Dakota, she added, was also the first state in the nation to ban the use of Tik-Tok, to control bank digital currency, and to ban men from participating in women's sports.

Referring to a series of national television commercials for her state, in which she incompetently, but humorously, plays a worker in different fields of labor, Noem said the successful ads led to a 60 percent increase of licensed electricians and a 78 percent increase of plumbers in the state.

She believes that South Dakota is a better place when the economy is strong, government is limited, and people are free to exercise their God-given rights. She preserves a system of no state income tax, and is a staunch supporter of the Second Amendment

Noem – a wife, mother, and grandmother – also described her early life in the state, as a rancher, farmer, and businesswoman prior to entering politics. Receiving a standing ovation at the end of her keynote address, she closed her remarks stating,

"Hope is optimism with a plan, and I am blessed to live in this country."

Everyone in attendance received a signed copy of her new book: "No Going Back: The Truth On What's Wrong With Politics And How We Move America Forward."



Also on the program, **Florida 7th District Representative Mike Waltz**, who is the first Green Beret elected to Congress, said it was "disgraceful" and "disgusting" the way President Biden shut down the operation in Afghanistan that led to the deaths of 13 U.S. service personnel. And the retired Army Colonel pointed out that "we have to have election integrity in the next

election."

Waltz urged the audience members that "If you see 'Made in China' on a product you are buying, put it down. We do not have to keep funding our greatest adversary." He serves in Congress on the China Task Force and has sponsored legislation to reduce American reliance on Chinese minerals and to secure schools from Chinese espionage.

Socialism, he added, "will not work. Focus on individual liberty. Good ideas got us through wars and will help us win."

Brevard Republican Executive Committee Chair Rick Lacey, who served as MC of the evening, closed the program announcing the winners for the year in four categories, and presenting plaques to **Jason Hull** of Edward Jones as Business Representative of the Year; **Supervisor of Elections Tim Bobanic** as Public Official of the Year; **BREC Precinct Committeewoman Connie Smith** as Volunteer of the Year; and **BREC District 5 Chair Dave Fosdick** as Republican of the Year.



POLITICAL JOTTINGS AND DOTTINGS

--In May 21 Republican Presidential Primaries, former President Donald Trump won 93 percent of the vote in Oregon, and 85 percent in Kentucky. There was

a special election that date in California's 20th Congressional District, in which Republican State Assemblyman Vince Fong won the race to fill the unexpired term of former House Speaker Kevin McCarthy, who resigned from Congress earlier this year.

In Maryland's Republican Primary Election on May14, Trump won the presidential ballot with 80 percent of the votes cast. Former Governor Larry Hogan captured the party's U.S. Senate nomination with 61 percent; and in West Virginia results, termlimited Governor Jim Justice won the Senate race with 61 percent of the vote, while Trump carried 85 percent of the presidential ballots, and Attorney General Patrick Morrisey won the state's Republican gubernatorial race with 34 percent of the vote in a six-way race. In another primary on that date, Trump won 80 percent of the vote in Nebraska.

Trump also captured 78 percent of the ballots in Indiana on May 7 in that state's presidential primary.

According to "The Daily Wire," top Republican members of Congress have revealed that President Joe Biden's special envoy to Iran – Robert Malley – is under federal criminal investigation, for allegedly transferring classified material to his personal email and cellphone, at which point they were stolen by a hostile foreign actor. Malley reportedly was linked to an "Iranian spy ring" operating to shift U.S. policy to favor the Islamic nation. -0-

--Findings by the independent organization Verity Vote suggest that the selection of early voting sites in North Carolina may be in breach of state laws requiring political neutrality, because at least 16 locations across 12 counties are situated on college campuses - a decision that appears to benefit Democrats due to the predominant political leanings of students. The organization concluded that such skewed polling locations could unfairly influence electoral outcomes, calling for an urgent review and relocation of these sites to more politically neutral areas. "One-Stop voting locations in precincts that disproportionately favor either party create an unfair advantage," Veritv Vote emphasized. -0-

--Florida Senator Rick Scott has joined his colleagues John Thune of South Dakota and John Cornyn of Texas in the bid to serve as U.S. Senate Republican leader, succeeding the outgoing Mitch McConnell of Kentucky. "I believe that our voters want us to use this leadership election to make a choice to upend the status quo in Washington," Scott said in a letter to colleagues.

The secret ballot vote will take place after the November elections.

Beware The Ides Of November

I have had discussions recently about the lead Donald Trump has over Joe Biden. While Trump leads in most polls a closer look at the statistics with a critical eye



shows most polls are within the margin of error. I doubt many people actually looked closely at the polls. Do we know who if those polled were "likely voters" or "registered voters? How big or small was the sampling? What were the ages of those

polled. What were the demographics of those polled? How about economic factors such as annual income? Without knowing these factors people fall into the trap of believing what they are being fed.

Looking at one poll that is often quoted, <u>The Quinnipiac</u> University Poll conducted in

April. 1,429 self-identified registered voters nationwide were surveyed from April 18th - 22nd with a margin of error of +/-2.6 percentage points. "Self-Identified"? It isn't difficult to obtain voter rolls to check if those targeted were actually registered.

Then there are the outlier polls which many "talking heads" on both sides of the argument tend to use. Find a poll of 500 people in rural areas usually trends towards conservatives. The converse is true when the poll is conducted in metropolitan areas.

How about education levels. Will those with college degrees answer the same as high school diploma respondents?

There are so many factors that have to be considered that often times it is impossible to determine whether the poll is true of targeted to appeal to certain constituencies.

Buried in The Quinnipiac Poll is the following information ".... this telephone survey was conducted from April 18 – 22, 2024 throughout the contiguous United States. Responses are reported for 1,603 adults 18 years and older with a margin of sampling error of +/- 2.5 percentage points. The survey includes 1,429 self-identified registered voters with a margin of sampling error of +/- 2.6 percentage points. Margins of sampling error for subgroups are available upon request." That's 1429 out of 161.42 million registered in 2024. Is this a fair poll? It's hard to determine.

This year is going to be more difficult to understand polls. There are polls that consider whether Trump is convicted or not. There are polls that ask about the approval ratings of both candidates. Then there are the polls that include just Rober Kennedy, while other include Jill Stein and Cornell West.

This year's issues will be major factors. Democrats are using the false claim that abortions have been outlawed in the nation while the truth is the issue is left to the states as the Constitution directs. Immigration, inflation, support of Ukraine are some of the issues to watch. What may be the most influential concern is Israel. The United States was one of the first Nations to recognize Israel's independence. This year the Democrats have given into the lefts view of the situation. They have brought HAMAS up to equal status with Israel. How this will affect the vote has not been polled as far as I know. Another issue is found in the Quinnipiac poll: SPREADING OF FALSE INFORMATION. "Nearly three-quarters of voters (74 percent) are either very concerned (48 percent) or somewhat concerned (26 percent) that another country is spreading false information inside the United States in an attempt to stir up divisions to weaken the United States, while 24 percent of voters are either not so concerned (11 percent) or not concerned at all (13 percent)."

I took apart for you some of Quinnipiac Polling data. The list of polls is extensive. To see a list of major presential polls see RealClear Politics report <u>HERE</u>.

What I caution is that none of these polls take one major factor into consideration. Democrats will all come home at the end of the day. Recently Trump had a rally in The Bronx. Rep. Alexandria Ocasio-Cortez had this to say about it: "This is an attempt to, I think, trick some of our folks here.... What we see here is that former President Trump has been in court, he has mounting legal fees, and a lot of this is about covering the increasingly precarious financial situation that he's in."

Regarding concerns about crowd size and accountability, Ocasio-Cortez said she believes that the rally will be composed of out-of-towners rather than Bronx residents. "I think in terms of a crowd size, it's less about the size and more about who is there for holding a rally in the Bronx," she said. "And if there are folks from different states that are traveling in—which tends to be common with the Trump campaign—then I think it kind of shows that he kind of has to travel around with folks instead of going into communities and actually building authentic support." (SPECTRUM NEWS NY1)

Cathy Hochul, Governor of New York said about the same rally: "Well, I'll tell you, won't make a difference at all, Jake (Tapper), and that is for Donald Trump to be the ringleader, and invite all his clowns to a place like the



Bronx. New York will never ever support Donald Trump for president,"

"We know him better than anyone. And that means we understand what he's all about, just for himself. So, this state will go solidly behind Joe Biden for president as it has in the past. So, he wants to spend his time doing these made-up fake rallies and retaining their supporter here, be my guest, because while you're doing that, Donald Trump, Joe Biden's out there on the other side, making sure he's delivering for all Americans. I'm happy to see these two got the talking points and are sticking to them.

The governor is likely correct that the Bronx and New York State will not vote for Trump. but that makes her. Democrats, in the end, will come home to the party.

We must be there for the Country. We must turn this disastrous Biden administration around if we can. It may take more than one conservative administration to right the ship. Voting is the only way to do this.

MAYFIELD MINUTE

The sales tax holiday for disaster preparedness will take place June 1-14 for the 2024 hurricane season, which is from June 1 through November 30. The

sales tax holiday is part of a wide-ranging tax package (HB 7073) that the Florida Legislature passed during the 2024 session and Governor Ron DeSantis signed on May 7.

Hurricane predictors project a "turbulent" hurricane season with more than 21 named storms according to the World Meteorological Organization. Colorado State University researchers also have forecasted a "very, very busy hurricane season" based on expected La Niña conditions that would result in hurricane-favorable wind shear conditions and warm water.

A second sales tax holiday for disaster preparedness will be held August 14th thru September 6th.

The sales tax holidays include items from batteries, fuel tanks, portable radios and portable generators in addition to sales tax exemptions on pet supplies and medicines.

Since the close of the 2024 Legislation Session, Governor DeSantis has signed 207 bills into law, vetoed two bills, 27 remain pending his action, and 77 have not yet been sent for his consideration. -0-

The Space Training and Readiness Command (STARCOM) will now officially be headquartered at Patrick Space Force Base (PSFB). In May 2023, PSFB and Cape Canaveral Space Force Station were named as the presumptive home for STARCOM.

STARCOM is "responsible for the deliberate development, education and training of space professionals in addition to the development of space warfighting doctrine, tactics, techniques and procedures, and the operational test and evaluation of Space Force systems," according to an Air Force press release. -0-

Governor DeSantis has approved \$4.9 million in the state budget to provide more emergency and support services for victims of human trafficking. Through this funding, the Department of Children and Families is establishing a \$900,000 grant opportunity for law enforcement agencies across the state. The funding will ensure officers are equipped with the tools to identify and respond to human trafficking incidents effectively. This investment in training ensures that first responders are better prepared to address these complex situations.

A significant part of the bill is the replacement of the National Trafficking Hotline with the Florida Human Trafficking hotline. It includes changing awareness signs across the state to represent the Florida Human Trafficking Hotline, and additional protections for minors from exploitation and the strengthening of law enforcement's ability to address trafficking-related crimes are included in the legislation. -0-

In a testament to Florida's commitment to our military, DeSantis has announced a \$2.3 million grant to support military communities across the state. These grants allocated through the Defense Infrastructure Grant Program will support the economic growth of military communities in Florida and provide crucial resources to those protecting the nation. -0-

The Space Coast Economic Development Commission will receive a grant in the amount of \$82,500 and the City of Cocoa will receive a grant in the amount of \$135,000. The funds received will be used for infrastructure improvements to the water distribution system and to increase the resiliency of the water distribution network serving Patrick Space Force Base and Cape Canaveral Space Force Station.

His site is a national treasure of articles and videos decimating, through satire, the Left and "woke" culture. The Bulldog Award recipient for Outstanding Columnist: is Salena Zito of the "Washington Examiner," the "Middle America Whisperer," who relays the views and passions of the heartland to those on the coasts. The Bulldog Award recipient for Outstanding Investigative Journalism is Peter Schweizer, who is the go-to expert on all things China, particularly of late, the Chinese payment scandals involving Joe and Hunter Biden. On May 23, The U.S. Supreme Court, by a 6-3 vote, approved the congressional map drawn by South Carolina's Republican State Legislature after a lower court ruled earlier that it improperly diluted the power of Black voters through racial gerrymandering. The decision means

the state's representation in the U.S. House of Representatives likely will remain at six Republicans and one Democrat.... On May 15, the high court cleared the way – by the same 6-3 margin – for Louisiana to use in the 2024 elections, a new congressional map that contains two majority Black districts. A lower court had barred the state from using the new map on the grounds that legislators had relied too heavily on race when they drew the new map...And on May 9 – in yet another 6-3 vote – the court ruled that authorities do not have to provide a quick hearing when they seize property used in drug crimes, even when it belongs to "innocent owners." The justices rejected the claims of two Alabama women who had to wait more than a year for their cars to be returned. Police had stopped the cars when they were being driven by other people and seized the vehicles after finding drugs in them.



Three Florida Congressman -Bill Posey, Dan Webster and Franklin Scott were instrumental in getting the House of Representatives to block the ability of Communist China from from the Federal benefiting Aviation Administration's research and development Working with the programs.

House Science, Space and Technology Committee, they were able to incorporate security language in the research and development portion of the FAA reauthorization bill passed by both the House and Senate, since China has long been known to steal American intellectual property or to influence American research. Posey said China "views all of its entities through a military lens and works quietly to gain influence all over the world." Webster called the Chinese Communist Party "a threat to America's national and economic security." And Franklin said that "Our provision will safeguard the important

R&D included in the FAA reauthorization bill from malign CCP-influence."

"Winners" this month are:

--18-year-Old Aiden Studer in Manchester, New Hampshire, for pushing over a porta-potty in Derryfueld Park, causing it to land



with the door or the pavement, and trapping a young mother and her four-year-old daughter inside, covering them in filth. Nearby bystanders did come to their aid, and police were able to arrest Studer, charging him with two counts of criminal restraint, criminal mischief, and assault on a police officer for throwing a shoe at him prior to the arrest.

--Officials at Jurupa Unified School District in California, for firing Jurupa Valley High School physical education teacher Jessica Tapia, for following her Christian beliefs and refusing to follow directions to accommodate transgender and "gender non-conforming" students by using their "preferred pronouns," allowing them to use the locker rooms and bathrooms aligned with their "gender identity," and refusing to inform parents of a student's changed gender identity. But Tapia has the last laugh. With the help of the Advocates for Faith & Freedom law firm, she sued the school district for wrongful termination – and it has now agreed to pay her \$360,000 to settle the case. --Kara Davis, the executive director of teaching and learning at Michigan's Saline School District, for warning teachers in an email that it is now against the rules to use terms like "boy" and "girl," calling them "students" or "children" instead. She also said teachers are forbidden from dividing the students into groups based on sex, since "such behavior would cause harm to transgender and non-binary students."

YOU CAN'T MAKE THIS UP

--Former White House Press Secretary Jen Psaki – in her new book "Say More" – falsely claimed that President Biden "did not check his watch" during the somber transfer ceremony for 13 U.S. troops who had been killed in the



Afghanistan withdrawal. She claimed that Biden, who appeared to be insensitive and concerned about how much time had passed, "only looked at his watch after the ceremony had ended." But photos, videos, and media fact-checkers at the time of the ceremony had already confirmed the President's snub of the fallen troops' families, and without commenting on her claim's accuracy, Psaki later acknowledged that "the detail in a few lines of the book about the exact number of times he looked at his watch will be removed in future reprint and ebook version." Meanwhile, her dismissive comments about Biden sparked outrage among Gold Star families, with Darin Hoover, the father of one of the slain soldiers, saying she "is just a vile, shameless human being trying to make money off of our kids' backs and rewrite history and establish those lies for the Biden administration on their failures, their catastrophic failures. It's been nothing but lies all along."

--For more than 100 years, the Boy Scouts of America helped shape the lives of countless skilled, God-fearing, patriotic young men. But that is no longer the case, since the organization caved to woke extremist demands. It dropped restrictions against members engaging in homosexual acts, allowed gay men to join the leadership ranks, and invited any girl who claims to be a "boy" to become a member. As a result, many long-time scouts quit. Now, for final the nail in their coffin, the group announced it is changing to a gender-neutral name – the Boy Scouts of America will soon be called "Scouting America."

--To honor the memory of Georgia nursing student Laken Riley, who was murdered by an illegal alien, Republicans in New York State proposed passage of "Laken's Law," that would require local law enforcement to send arrest records and fingerprints to Immigration and Customs Enforcement officials whenever authorities arrest a non-citizen. But the measure was killed in the left-leaning State Assembly when the Democrat members refused to endorse it. "New York thus remains a preferred destination for people illegally crossing our southern border, especially those who intend to commit crimes," said Republican Assemblyman Jarrett Gandolfo, who introduced the proposed legislation. --In an NBC News interview, as well as speaking during a panel discussion in Atlanta, Doug Emhoff, the husband of Vice President Kamala Harris, said that men should be more active in advocating for abortion, and the killing of preborn children in the womb is a "family issue" as well as one of fairness to women. He also called laws protecting preborn children a "medical healthcare crisis."

--Harrison County, West Virginia Judge Thomas Bedell has granted a temporary injunction on behalf of four Lincoln Middle School girls who refused to compete against a transgender athlete from Bridgeport Middle School who then won a track and field shot-put event. School officials originally ruled that the girls would be barred from future meets for not participating. West Virginia Attorney General Patrick Morrisey said "These girls didn't disrupt anything when they protested. They should be commended, not punished."

--Baltimore's Johns Hopkins University – long considered one of America's most respected schools – is now fully in bed with woke extremism. The dean of Hopkins' Carey Business School, Alexander Triantis, says in a posted video: "I use the pronouns he and him. We strongly support the principles of Diversity, Equity, Inclusion and belonging, and we want our school to be a place where everyone feels welcome and a part of our community. And we want our graduates to emulate these ideals in society." He continued, "One of the things each of us can do to express our values, is to share our own pronouns and respect the pronoun choices of others. It's a small step that tells others we are a welcoming community, we embrace diversity, and we support all gender identities."

--After liberal officials at Atrisco Heritage Academy High School in Albuquerque, New Mexico, quietly arranged for a local drag queen to perform at the school's annual prom, the school district replaced principal Irene Cisneros and put several other officials on administrative leave. Outraged parents who learned about it demanded that all those involved be fired.

--It took four long years for the case to reach a trial, but two students who had been wrongfully expelled from St. Francis High School in Mountain View, California, finally got the justice they sought – a \$1 million judgment. Schools in the state are now on notice to provide "fair procedures" to students. The two had followed a doctor's recommendation to wear green acne face masks to correct teenage acne. A photo taken of them at the time became the center of a controversy, because school officials who saw it misinterpreted it as showing them in racial "blackface," and the boys were expelled without considering their evidence or offering any hearing. Their Dhillon Law Group legal team said that the jury at their trial finally cleared their names, stressing that "Schools re supposed to protect and nurture children, not sacrifice them when it is convenient for public relations purposes."

--After pro-Palestine protesters vandalized a wall at Case Western Reserve University in Cleveland, Ohio, the school hired an artist to use his spray-painting machine to clean up the graffiti. When a group of activists tried to stand in his way at the wall, he simply spray painted them as well.

--More from the Woke National Football League. When Kansas City Chiefs kicker Harrison Butker, a conservative Catholic, spoke at the commencement ceremony for Benedictine College in Atchison, Kansas, he criticized Pride Month and President Biden's policies on abortion and LGBTQ rights. But the NFL quickly distanced itself from his remarks, stating "they do not reflect the league's commitment to inclusion." A petition to have Butker – who is one of the top kickers in the league – removed from the Chiefs' roster has gained nearly 100,000 signatures. The liberal "Kansas City Star" newspaper even demanded that the Chiefs fire Butker and hire a female kicker in his place. For the NFL and Kansas Cityians, it seems to be another case of "cutting one's nose off to spite its face."

"Newly unsealed documents in Special Counsel Jack Smith's espionage case against Donald Trump demonstrate the FBI's plans to use deadly force – even if

the former president arrived at the scene. An exhibit filed by Trump in a motion to suppress evidence seized during the FBI's August 2022 raid of Mar-a-Lago revealed shocking new details about the bureau's plans.... The document is just one of many court filings recently ordered unsealed by Judge Aileen Cannon, who is presiding over the matter in southern Florida. In an August 3, 2022, operations order for "Plasmic Echo," the FBI's code name for the government's investigation into Trump's alleged mishandling of national defense material, FBI officials furnished instructions on how to proceed with the unprecedented raid. 'FBI [Washington Field Office] and FBI [Miami] agents and [Evidence Response Team] will effect a search of designated locations within Mar-a-Lago (MAL) to locate and seize classified information, NDI, and U.S. Government records as described in captioned search warrant,' the document read. The raid involved 25 Miami FBI agents, four Washington FBI agents, one unidentified individual from FBI Headquarters, one DOJ attorney, and the assistant U.S. Attorney from the Southern District of Florida. But according to the operations order, law enforcement was not preparing a routine search for presidential papers. One section of the plan described how agents should handle the potential for use of deadly force.... The FBI also considered various scenarios should the former president unexpectedly arrive at his residence during the raid. Agents were also prepared to go door-to-door to terrorize Mar-a-Lago guests if staff refused to turn over room keys.... In addition to lock-picking equipment, FBI agents were armed with 'Standard Issue Weapon, Ammo, and Handcuffs' as well as 'medium and large sized bolt cutters.' Perhaps most shockingly, the FBI team included a

medic to tend to anyone 'injured' during the raid. The operations order identified a nearby trauma center with directions how to get there.... Additional exhibits in the unsealed motion also indicate agents ransacked the bedrooms of Melania and Barron Trump.....The head of the Washington FBI Field Office at the time was Steven D'Antuono. In addition to spearheading the criminal investigation into the events of January 6, which included his inability to identify and charge the so-called pipe bomber, D'Antuono led the Detroit FBI Field office in 2020 when the FBI manufactured an entrapment scheme to make it appear that Trump supporters plotted to kidnap and kill Michigan Governor Gretchen Whitmer in 2020. D'Antuono retired in November 2022. Attorney General Merrick Garland approved the FBI raid of Mar-a-Lago."

These surveys all are weighted based on actual exit polls from 2020 and all show Trump winning big! Harvard-Harris shows Trump beating Biden and Kennedy by 46-39-12. Rasmussen has Trump ahead of Biden and Kennedy by 48-36-8. And The New York Times/Sienna poll has Trump ahead by four among likely voters but only by one among registered voters. For the rest ---mostly showing a very close race between Biden and Trump — there are real doubts. So, let's take a journey into the weeds and dissect the surveys that show Biden ahead or rate the race as basically tied. Economist/YouGov on May 8 published findings showing the two-way race tied at 43-43. The problem with that survey is that among the 1,596 registered voters they surveyed, there were only 444 Republicans or 28%. But in 2020 exit polls indicated that 36% of those who voted were, indeed, Republicans. The survey apparently packed its sample with Democrats.... The Morning Consult survey of May 14th suffers from a different defect that undermines its finding that Trump leads Biden by only 44-43. The Morning Consult poll only surveyed registered voters not likely voters. In 2020, 66 percent of voting-eligible people and 71% of registered voters actually turned out to cast ballots - a record. But while 155 million registered and eligible voters did actually vote, 63 million did not. The Morning Consult Poll reports that among those who were eligible to vote, Trump and Biden are neckand-neck. But what about the 29% of their sample who were non-voters?....A survey by ABC News/Ipsos on May 5 also showed a tight race with Biden in the lead 46-45. In a novel effort to exclude voters who would, ultimately, abstain, the firm asked people to rate their chance of voting on a one to one

hundred scale. But having taken great pains to include only actual voters, the polltakers then let everybody into their sample so that 21% of the interviews were with people who admitted that there was less than a 50/50 chance that they would actually vote....A survey taken by Marist College on April 22-25, also showed Biden ahead by 48-50. But, unlike the other firms, it drew its sample from a list of telephone numbers, not of voters. Marist found 1,109 registered voters who it interviewed out of 1,199 people with whom they spoke. But unfortunately, they were too Democratic.... As the election approaches and Biden's ratings remain dismal, the questionable polls are proliferating. Are pollsters desperate to make Biden look competitive enough to run? Yahoo posted a survey on May 10-14 showing a tie race between Trump and Biden. But, once again, it is based on a biased sample with only 27% Republicans (as noted, it should be 36% Republican according to the 2020 exit polls)In analyses of the 2020 polling, a nonpartisan panel of experts from the Pew Research Center found that 'it is clear that Trump's strength was not fully accounted for in many, if not most, polls.' Understatement of the year. And, whether deliberate or not, it looks like the bias continues."

The ladies collected all they had left and sent for our bottles of the water – drinking as directed as soon as they arrived. This will make you a believer, because here they are today:






