## General Election Time to Get Out the Vote

The General Election is upon us! With just 6 weeks to Election Day many things will be happening rapid fire to bring it to completion. Ballots to overseas voters and sample ballots for your precinct have already been sent in the mail. Political parties and candidates are organizing to do their final push to turn out voters.

Here are some important deadlines you should know about;

Mailing of Mail-in Ballots: October 3, 2024

**Last Day to register to vote:** October 7, 2024 (if you know someone who just moved to Florida or turned 18 encourage them to register)

Last Day to Request a Mail Ballot to be sent: October 24, 2024 by 5:00 p.m. (will you be traveling on Election Day, do you have a child away at school, please get a mail in ballot to so you/they can vote)

**Early Voting:** October 21 - November 2, 2024 (available at 10 different locations, vote early in person, the lines are shorter)

Election Day: November 5, 2024 from 7:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m.

From the political party perspective, the Brevard Republican Party is undertaking a multi –faceted campaign to ensure that Republican candidates are elected;

- The Board has appropriated up to \$60,000 dollars for the design and procurement of campaign collateral (door hangers, mailers, and signs) which will start to appear throughout the County.
- As with the Primary, we are collaborating with the Republican Party of Florida election integrity team in organizing Poll Watchers, as well as observing the Logic and Accuracy test of the election equipment and attending canvassing board meetings.
- We have divided the county into three sections and will be going door to door to provide voters with information on the slate of Republican candidates.
- There will also be organized phone calling to provide information and offer assistance in voting.
- You have likely seen them groups of volunteers out representing our Republican candidates waving flags on strategic street corner. Join us, or honk and give a friendly wave.
- Of course all the local Republican clubs are doing similar activities with similar intent, to educate voters and get them out to vote.
- When in-person voting starts we will have voter information tents in place for the 13 days of early voting. Currently we are recruiting volunteers and showing them the ropes.

The sole purpose of these activities is to inform voters of the best candidates to vote for and to encourage them to vote. This year's election may be the most important one in our lifetime – I know you have heard that before - but given the rapid decay of our great Country over the past four years, it is true. Many of us have heard that the Republican Party has a 1 million more registered voters than Democrats. Please don't let that make you complacent. Be sure to Vote.
